CONSENT:

As the parent or legal guardian of the student(s) signing below, I grant permission for my child(ren) to participate in computer and iPad use; and to access the Internet and the school's networked computer services. While we endeavor to provide effective supervision and monitoring of computer use, please be aware that it is possible that your child may find material on the Internet that you would consider objectionable. The school has a filter that restricts access to material that is inappropriate in the school environment. We have installed SonicWall™ to limit access to inappropriate material. However, we cannot guarantee that your child will not gain access to inappropriate sites. We would like to encourage you to use this as an opportunity to have a discussion with your child about your family values and your expectation about how these values should guide your child's activities while they are on the Internet.
